

**MPCG School Board**

**September 22, 2008**

**Re: Mill Levy**

The May-Port CG Board of Education met in special session at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, September 22, 2008 with the following board members present: Capouch, Eide, Ellingson, Klath, Lorenz, Rekken, Reynolds, Torgeson; board member Elliott was absent. Also present, Supt. Bradner and Business Manager Kville.

President Reynolds called the meeting to order.

Supt. Bradner updated the board on the proposed property tax relief plan that will put a cap on mills for school districts. The estimated revenue and proposal for mills for the 2008-2009 school year was reviewed.

The taxable valuation for the district for 2008-2009 is \$11,755,739 (counties of Traill, Steele, and Cass).

Approved 2008-2009 budget: \$4,873,975.00  
Estimated revenue at 185 mills: \$4,711,817.72  
(\$162,157.28) *deficit spend*

It was recommended to set the mill levy at 185.

Lorenz/Torgeson made a motion to approve the mill levy at 185 mills. On a roll call vote, all members voted yes, motion carried.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:45 pm.
