The program is intended to supplement the diets of children over the weekend, and it is provided through a partnership between Micah Mission (a project of Mayville United Ministries) and the Great Plains Food Bank.

Every Friday, *Blessings in a Backpack* provides a bag full of child-friendly, shelf-stable food for a child to take home and eat over the weekend. Included are foods like cereal, pudding, soup, fruit, granola bars, microwavable meals, and snacks. With your approval, we can send a bag of food home with your child every Friday during the school year.

The program is confidential. Your child can participate only with your approval. There will never be a charge for it. It is funded entirely through private donations and grants.
