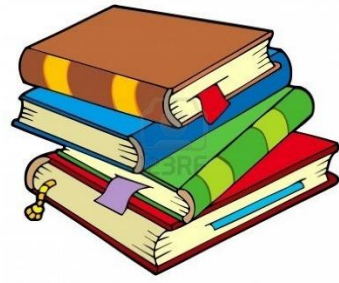

### From the School Nurse....

February is National Children's Dental Health Month. The American Dental Association has been sponsoring this event since 1950. At that time, a single day was set aside to promote children's dental health. Since establishing healthy oral habits and routines are so important in children, the entire month is now dedicated to children's dental health.

This year's campaign slogan is "Brush your teeth with fluoride toothpaste and clean between your teeth for a healthy smile". We will be observing dental health month at PBJ by discussing why dental health is important and what we need to do to keep our teeth healthy.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students will be having a dental screening through the ND Department of Health. The screening will take place March 7th and is optional. The screening does not take the place of a regular dental exam. Students that participate in the screening will receive a toothbrush, information about oral health and will receive a summary of the oral screening. Consent forms have been sent home with the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students. Parents/guardians are asked to return the consent forms to school if they do not want their child screened. If forms are not returned to the school, consent is being given for the oral screening. All screening information is confidential.
